Polyarts began in 1974 as a demonstration of various arts and crafts to showcase the talents of the local community. Since then it has grown into a day long event with many professional craftspeople, performing artists and community groups participating throughout the day. Polyarts is a family-friendly day with something for everyone, be it food, music, crafts or other entertainment.

To be considered for Polyarts, please complete and confirm the following by April 1, 2017:

1. ALL items are made by me, the crafter
2. Completed **application, photos, and check** are mailed to Hopkinton Polyarts by April 1, 2017.
 - a. A maximum of 4 photos of your craft including one of your booth set-up (**no samples, web sites or e-mail pictures**). Photos will **NOT** be returned.
 - b. Remember these photos represent your work in a competitive show, we strongly recommend that you print on quality paper size 4x6 or larger (please no slides or CD/DVD). Without photos you will not be considered for our event.
 - c. Checks payable to Hopkinton Polyarts.
3. Please list your name, business name and price range of merchandise on the back of the photos.
4. Be sure to check off how you wish to be notified - via email or mail (self-addressed, stamped envelope needed).
