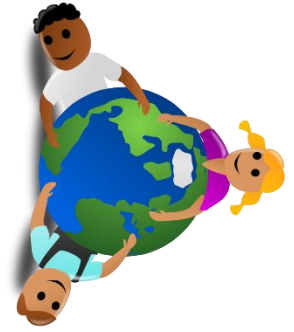


MARTIN LUTHER KING
